

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Instructions, Rules and Regulations

A. ADMISSIONS

- 1. Admission is open to all irrespective of caste, creed or religion.
- 2. Registration must be done on the prescribed form issued by the school.
- 3. Registration of a child does not guarantee the admission in the class applied for.
- 4. Registration/Admission/Tuition fees etc. once paid are not refundable.
- 5. Admissions are granted purely on merit. Prior registration for an admission test is essential for classes I to IX.
- 6. Pupils seeking admission in Nursery should complete three year before the 1st of April. A corresponding age scale is fixed for the subsequent classes.
- 7. There will be no written test for LKG and HKG; instead there will be an introduction of the child.
- 8. Pupils seeking admission to class I to IX & XI shall be subjected to entrance test provided they meet the age requirements.
- 9. Application form for registration/ admission is available at the end of this prospectus. The form is to be completed and submitted to the school office along with the following documents:
 - a. Photocopy of Municipal Birth Certificate (Original) to be brought at the time of depositing Registration Form.
 - b. Photocopy of Certificate of Mark sheet of Father's and Mother's highest qualification.
 - c. Photocopy of Mark sheet/Report card of child's previous class.
 - d. Original Transfer Certificate.
 - e. Photocopy of residence proof.

- f. Aadhar Card of the Student.
- g. Aadhar Card of the Parents/Guardian.
- h. Photocopy of the Category Certificate (duly attested).
- I. Income certificate of the Parents.
- 10. All the documents must be submitted when the child gets admission in the school. Non submission of the above mentioned document at the time of admission will render the claim for admission invalid.
- 11. At the time of submission of the registration form, the exact date and time of the entrance test is to be obtained from the school office.
- 12. The list of children found eligible for admission will be notified on the school notice board within three days.

Parents are to deposit admission fee and school fee $(1^{st}$ Quarter) at the time of admission.

- 13. The Principal reserves the right to suspend or dismiss any pupil if his/her conduct or progress is unsatisfactory.
- 14. The Principal reserves the right to accept/ reject any application for admission/ re-admission without assigning any reason.

B. WITHDRAWLS

- 1. If a Parent wants to withdraw his/her ward/s name from school, then the parent will have to write an application for T.C and submit it to the Principal. After the application is accepted, the T.C. will be issued after 15 working days from the date of submission of the application.
- 2. The Application should be given within 1 month after the declaration of the final result or else you will be liable to pay the 1st quarter fees for the next session.
- 3. School leaving certificate/T.C. will not be issued until all dues are cleared.

C. FEE RULES: _____

- 1. Fees once paid are not refundable under any circumstance.
- 2. Fee must be paid for quarter as given hereunder:-
 - 1^{st} Quarter Last Date 20^{th} April
 - 2^{nd} Quarter Last Date 20^{th} July
 - 3^{rd} Quarter Last Date 20^{th} October
 - 4^{th} Quarter Last Date 20^{th} January
- 3. The Fees should be paid by cash/cheque at the Fee Counter of *KARNATAKA BANK*.
- 4. If the Fee booklet is lost it will be replaced on payment of Rs. 100/-
- 5. Parents are advised to check that the bank returns them their copy duly signed and stamped.
- 6. This Fee Booklet must be submitted along with the application for Transfer Certificate.
- 7. School Fees is payable for full 12 months of the year. No deduction will be made for broken period of absence.

- 8. Students who do not pay the fees will not be allowed to sit for the exams unless all dues are paid on time.
- 9. If the last date to deposit the fee is a holiday, the fees will be accepted without fine on the following working day.
- 10. A fine of Rs 10/- per day will be charged after the due date of every quarter.

Cheques are to be made in the favor of *"All Saints" Church School"*. Kindly write your child's name, father's name and class with section, at the back of the cheque. Only account payee cheques will be accepted. Outstation cheques will not be accepted.



EVALUATION AND PROMOTION

- 1. No candidates will be admitted to any of the examinations unless all the schools dues have been paid in full.
- 2. Regular periodical tests will be conducted in addition to the terminal examinations. Marks obtained in all the tests and terminal examinations will be taken into consideration for promotion.
- 3. Those who absent themselves in any subject shall not be awarded any position and shall not be reexamined. In case of grave illness, a medical certificate should be produced.
- 4. Result declared at the end of the academic year is final and no request for re-examination/ reevaluation shall be entertained. Application for the verifications of marks may be considered in special cases at the discretion of the principal.
- 5. Parents/Guardians are requested to come and examine the result card of their wards and return it duly signed to the class teacher. Signature found in the progress report should match the specimen signature in the diary/ admission form.

VISIT TO SCHOOL _____

Parents/ Guardians may visit the school and the teachers only on PTM 's or Saturday after the class. At other times, with the prior permission of the Principal. PTM dates will be mentioned to the parents in the school calendar. It is compulsory for the parents to attend each and every PTM regularly.

UNIFORM _____

Uniform must be stitched to the specifications prescribed regarding the cloth and design. All the students are expected to come neat and tidy. Details of the uniform could also be obtained from the school office. On all class days and at school functions the children are expected to wear the uniform prescribed for the season. Each child must be provided with a sufficient number of uniforms. It is compulsory to wear the school uniform on the following occasions: classes, for trips/picnics, for inter school functions and competitions.
